Skuodas district R. Granauskas public library is a budgetary institution founded in 1939. Currently, the library consists of 15 branches all over the Skuodas district. Our library serves as a centre of information research and the provider of informal educational and leisure activities. The Library is available to everyone. The library is involved in various national projects in order to become modern and serve the needs of its users.

The library provides the following electronic services: book ordering, interlibrary loan, reservation, extension of a term of keeping a book etc. The library provides access to local and international databases, licensed in Lithuanian public libraries. The library organizes various training activities, excursions round the library, volunteers' activities, new book presentations, lectures, art exhibitions, cultural performances, programs for reader development, etc.

Other important remarks

A few facts about Skuodas:

- Skuodas is a town located in the Klaipėda County, in northwestern Lithuania, on the border with Latvia;
- The town of Skuodas is the centre of Skuodas district;
- Skuodas is a small town: a little more than 5000 inhabitants in the town (more than 19 000 inhabitants all over the district);
- Skuodas is a beautiful and safe town.

Practicalities

You will volunteer 30-35 h/week. There will be one person (a tutor) in your organization responsible for planning the schedule with you and advising on everyday tasks.

You will be provided with a monthly ticket for public transport (if applicable).

You will be accommodated in a private room in a shared apartment (3-5 people).

You will be part of the group of volunteers of the coordinating organization A.C. Patria.

You will be able to study Lithuanian language with the OLS language program

You will be participating in an on-arrival and a mid-term (if applicable) trainings.

You will have regular meetings with your mentor.
