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## STEP INTO THE FUTURE



"Step into the future!" is the youth exchange project is carried for the period of six months (01.02.2017 -31.07.2017). The purpose of the proposed project is to implement informal education among young unemployed people to increase their knowledge and skills that will help them in job search and thereby become more competitive in the labor market. The general objective of the proposed project is to reduce unemployment among young people in countries with a below-average youth employment level compared to the EU average. The specific objective of the proposed project is to inform young people about the methods of job search (making a quality CV, making inquiries and motivation letters, simulating job vacancies, job search plans, selfemployment methods through social and green entrepreneurship). The project's objective is also to exchange knowledge and experience among participants and to familiarize them with examples of good practice and to encourage active and self-seeking job search.

Participants went through a job interview simulation, and they were supposed to devise a job search plan, write a CV, a letter of motivation, and a self-employment plan.

## **Project results:**

- successfully conducted non-formal education for 23 participants on how to boost competitivnes on job market

- produced a newsletter to be forwarded to at least 50 NGOs in each country involved in a project that will include a description of the project and activities, a description of the non-formal learning methods used in the main activities and learning outcomes;
